Students were divided into 3 groups; each interacted in 3 different domains of public

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Participation In Startup & Idea Fest 2022

BCA 8th semester student Mr. Dinesh Thapa represented LA GRANDEE in the ebeema startup idea fest, with his company, XDEZO Technologies, and became one of the top 5 finalists from the Gandaki Province.

It was organized on 1st April, 2022. 70 ideapreneurs and aspiring entrepreneurs from the province pitched their ideas, and eminent panel members assessed their ideas and scored them accordingly.

LA GRANDEE International College always encourages students to think of innovative ideas that solve



the societal and pain points of people. This is evident from several accolades LA GRANDEE has received over its two-decade-long history.

Requirements Analysis Competition

BCA students First-semester participated in a requirements analysis competition on 5 May 2022. Requirements analysis is crucial in project development, where we investigate whether the problem domain identified by the technical analyst is feasible to solve or not. The students in a group of 5 prepared consolidated requirements а paper on several topics, such as restaurant management, educational technology, e-commerce, ride-hailing,

BCA students are required to create a software project on various platforms as per the requirement of the BCA curriculum in spring semesters, namely second, fourth, sixth and eighth semesters. The BCA department assigns project supervisors each semester who oversee all the project development activities carried out by BCA students. The project orientation date ranged from March 11th to May 8th, and students were instructed on how to carry out project development activities. From requirement analysis to developing system diagrams, students were thoroughly guided by their respective supervisors. Students, according to their semester's requirements, create a project using various tools and platforms. Students in the second semester are required to create

a project using C programming

online bill payment, and the electronic electoral system.

Furthermore, Rohan Ghatane attained the best presenter award, and Group B, with team leader Sangam Subedi, won the best requirements paper out of 6 groups. This competition is based on the Programming Logic and Techniques syllabus, as they must study the program development life cycle, and requirements analysis is part of it.

Project-Work Orientation

language on a textual user interface, fourth-semester students implement graphical user interface elements and database using the Visual Basic programming platform for a software sixth-semester students project, are required to build a web-based application using development tools such as HTML, CSS, BOOTSTRAP, GIT, PHP and MYSQL, and finally, the eight-semester students do a capstone project where students need to do a 5 credit project which marks the culmination of 4 years of learning, and they implement mobile application development tools(DART, Flutter, Java for android, android studio, Swift and XCode) and web-based application tools(HTML, CSS, JAVASCRIPT, MYSQL). Students undergo regular progress review, mid-term presentations and the final evaluation procedure for grading by semester end.

Internship Report Presentation



On April 30, 2022, BCA 7th Semester students presented their final report of Internship. They are mandatorily required to complete at least 45 days long internship tenure as per the curriculum of BCA. Supervisor, Er Rishi Saran Khanal, provided the internship orientation on November 2nd, 2021.

Mr Subin Bhandari said it gave him a sneak peek of career experience that allowed them to put his knowledge into practice, enhance his leadership abilities, and get a competitive advantage when looking for a permanent position. Other students after the internship, expressed that they have obtained real-world experience, expanded their knowledge, and became able to assess whether they are in the proper professional direction or not. 29 students completed their internship within the duration Nov. 21, 2021 – Jan 3, 2022. 15 companies viz. Magic Cube Engineering, Brand Builder. Rangin Technologies, Urja Lab, Aama Trading, Airlink Communication, Airson Internet, Infomax Pvt. Ltd., Secure Services, Skein Soft Pvt. Ltd.. Xdezo Technologies, Airson Internet Pvt. Ltd., Medico's IT solutions, Dynamic Soft Tech and Virtual Technology, provided internship opportunities to the students. LA GRANDEE always recognizes such companies and is thankful for their valuable service.

Activities of BBA



Orientation on Summer Project

On 26 April 2022, orientation on Summer Project was conveyed to the students of BBA VI semester day and morning shift. The orientation was led by the BBA program coordinator Mr. Suraj Gaudel and acknowledged students with the objectives of the summer project, the data collection procedure, and the format of final report preparation and presentation. The contents of the project work were discussed thoroughly. Finally, the program was concluded by assigning the supervisor.

Strategic Analysis of Noodles Industry in Pokhara

A workshop relating to strategic management was conducted on April 28, 2022, for the BBA-VIII semester (Day/Morning) shift. Teaching and learning become fruitful when theoretical knowledge is adjoined with industry's current scenarios. Hence, to bridge the gap between theoretical and practical knowledge, the Case Analysis Workshop related to Noodles Industry in Pokhara was organized. During the workshop, students analyzed the noodle industries in Pokhara using Porter's Five Forces Model. They used chart paper, slides, and videos. The whole class was divided into various groups, and each group prepared their contents after doing their research and data collection. During the workshop, each team member gave their ideas, contemplated understanding of their topic and presented their findings.

College faculties, Mr. Muktinath Acharya and Mr. Sudeep Gurung evaluated the overall activities of the students and provided feedback to each group throughout this analytical project work.

Technical Training in Report Writing

A training session on Report Writing (esp. Google Form, and MS Word) was conducted on 29th April 2022 for the students of the BBA VI semester. This program was facilitated by Mr Sandeep Sharma and Mr Subin Bhandari from BCA VIII semester. The training was conducted separately for the day and morning shifts.

The main aim of the technical training was to orient students on the technical part of report writing. After the training, students were able to use MS Office tools to prepare reports, and they also learned the process of preparing questionnaires and data collection using Google form. A total of 70 students participated in the training.

Case Analysis through Role Playing

On April 29 2022, students of the BBA VI semester participated in a classroom activity where they had to solve a case related to corporate social responsibility through roleplaying. Students studied the case of Walmart, and as per the need of the case, the whole class were divided into two groups. One group had to support the act done by the management, whereas another group had to support the employee's voice. Each member of the group was assigned a different role in the company. A group of students raised their perspective on the issues related to women's discrimination in Walmart, whereas another group playing the role of the management was supporting the company's policies. Finally, they reached to the final solution and learned how different cases that emerged in an organization can be solved from the mutual understanding of different stakeholders in an organization.

Such case-based learning methodology further enhanced students' knowledge and understanding of the case scenarios and the practical implementations. The entire session was facilitated by our faculty member Ms Ganga Ghale.

Workshop on International Investment and Trade Theory

A workshop entitled "International Investment & Trade Theory in Context of Nepal" was conducted on 02 May 2022 for the students of BBA VIII (day and morning shifts). The workshop was aimed at learning investment and trade theories related to Nepal.

International Business is a broad introductory course included in the BBA program. Until the students understand the investment and trade theories, they will lack the real importance of international trade and investment.

Different groups of students prepared their contents before coming to the workshop. During the workshop, each team member imparted their ideas and understanding of the topic and presented their contents and opinion in the workshop. This is a self-learning, and collaborative approach to teaching-learning methods.

At the end of the workshop, our resource person, Mr Bishnu Prasad Timilsina, explained how international investment and trade theories impact the overall economy of any developing nation.



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Demo Press Release, Writing Media Plan, and Opinion Writing

BBA eighth semester students (Day and Morning Shift) experienced a simulated press conference where some played the role of media, some as the business organization and some as the audience.

Students were given different situations and they had to prepare for the press release. During this activity, all students launched their hypothetical scenarios for different products, namely Current Noodles, Nabil School of Social Entrepreneurship, CG Masala Cracker, Nepal Airlines, Nestle New Product, Prativa Management Charity, and Abishek Co. Limited to the audience and the dummy press media.

Students learnt about how an organization launches and sends messages about a new product using media. This prototype conference

was fully conducted under the instruction of faculty members Mr Achyut Poudel (day shift) and Mr Dipendra Pahari (morning shift) on 2nd May 2022.

Further, emphasizing more on the media sector, on 7th July 2022, BBA 8th semester students were involved in Writing Media Plan through which they understood regaining lost reputation after a particular incident, reinforcing the brand, increasing customer loyalty and confidence through media plan.

Also, on July 08, 2022, students were involved in Opinion Writing for and against "Usage of Plastic Bags" and "Vehicle Horns in Pokhara". Through such activities, students learned how to grab and influence the attention of the public through a written piece of information on their respective topics.

Organization Visit (Analysis of Marketing tools)

BBA fourth semester day and morning shift students visited different organizations on 13-14th June 2022. Students of the morning and day shift were instructed by faculty Mr Prawesh Gautam and Mr Nikesh Karmacharya respectively. This field visit was conducted to bridge the gap between education and hands-on experience related to Marketing. Students took interviews with entrepreneurs to understand their marketing stragtegies, programs and tools they used to promote their business.

As presented by students, they found that many organizations were using limited tools according to the needs and nature of the organization. They also found that some business organizations in Pokhara Valley were unable to use modern promotional tools due to a lack of knowledge related to ICT.

Debate Competition on CSR

All organizations cannot grow and become leading organizations without being involved in social activities. Students must understand how activities related to CSR link business organizations with society, the environment, customers and stakeholders. To understand the pros and cons of corporate social responsibility, students of BBA sixth semester Morning/Day shift participated in a debate competition on "CSR for Social Justice" which was held on 06 May 2022.

Faculty Ms. Ganga Ghale and Mr. Achyut Poudel facilitated the event for Morning and Day Shift respectively. Though it was a debate competition, it was actully an opportunity for students to understand the meaning of CSR, and how CSR supports societal development and thus provides justice for the community. Students Nisha Bharati from morning shift and Ashish Bhandari from day shift remained the competition winner.

Organization Visit

As a part of field-based learning, BBA VIII semester Finance Specialization students visited Kohinoor Securities Pvt. Ltd. (Broker 35) on 30-31st May 2022. For the finance specialization students, broker houses are the right platform to understand the practice of trading securities. After visiting broker houses, students were more clear about how people invest in securities of NEPSE. Students interacted with the broker house in charge of the Pokhara Branch. After the visit, they presented a report with a brief history of NEPSE and securities trading in Nepal and the status of the securities market in Pokhara. The presentation was evaluated and facilitated by faculty, Mr Prawesh Gautam.

Summer Project Report Presentation



BBA VI semester students completed their research study on 71 different areas of management. The study was conducted as their Project Work, and each student made an individual study on one specific area of management. The areas of study included

Banking and Finance, Corporate Houses, Travel and Tourism, Software Companies, Automobile Distributors, Event Management and the like. Each student accomplished the task as per the requirement of the curriculum and presented their study to their supervisor, department and the external evaluators on August 1 & 3, 2022).

Such activities provided them with an opportunity to learn the overall management and build prospective approaches to the respective areas of management. Mr Subash Malla, Lecturer Pokhara University School of Business, evaluated the students' project work as an external with necessary feedbacks. Students submitted their final report on 09 August.



Activities of BPH

One-Month Residential Community Health Diagnosis



The Community Health Diagnosis (CHD) of the 6th semester (Batch 2018) was conducted from June 15 to July 14, 2022. It is an integral part of field exposure in the community for developing skills and competencies required for public health professionals. It also helps to develop an attitude to identify health problems and health needs of the community and solve those problems through the Micro-health project (MHP).

Total of 39 students divided into three groups executed one-month residential CHD in wards no. 2, 3, and 6 of Aandhikhola rural municipality of Syangja district, which are Chilaunebaas, Bichari-Chautara Phaparthum. and respectively. Students from each group conducted a descriptive cross-sectional study of 400 household samples to identify health problems in that ward and designed a Micro-health project (MHP) as a health intervention for those identified health problems. Data were collected from both qualitative and quantitative approaches which were later analyzed using SPSS and MS-Excel.

Furthermore, students also carried out different health Intervention program at school and community. BPH Department Coordinator Mr Keshab Raj Adhikari visited the sites during the field and CHD Supervisor Mr Rajib Prasad Koirala observed the final community assembly in all 3 wards.

Integrated Concurrent Field Practice



BPH 4th semester students participated in the Integrated Concurrent Field practice, which focused on implementing theoretical knowledge in a pragmatic environment to enhance their skills while working in the community. The orientation was given to the students on 30th June 2022, and 38 students in 4 groups took part on the program.

Students conducted health intervention activities taken on behalf of individuals/ families and communities to enhance or safeguard health status. In the health intervention program, they carried out surveillance using systematic data collection

in 4 different slum areas located in Pokhara-25 Lampata, Pokhara-1 Shanti Tole, Prithvi Chowk, and Ratopahira. This program enhanced the outreach of health monitoring and provided counselling to the communities. The students met with local people, and elected officials of the designated areas. Furthermore, the students built coalition and alliance with the community and local authorities.

After collection of the data, the students analyzed the data and prepared a report. Since it is part of the BPH curricula, they had to present their report. The final defense of the report was carried out on 11th August 2022.

Waste Incinerator Model as MHP



A micro health project (MHP) is a short-term project that is planned, implemented, and evaluated in the community to minimize the prominent health problems within limited resources and time. It is designed to develop health-related awareness, skills, and self-reliance among the people on a priority basis of real needs. It involves using local resources resourcefully.

The students of the BPH 6th semester during the CHD activities built this non-degradable waste incinerator as MHP to manage improper waste disposal in 3 areas viz. Bichari Chautara, Chilaunebas and Phaparthung, Aandhikhola RM, Syangja district. This nondegradable waste incinerator helps to reduce the trash volume of waste into ash. Community people were so glad to use this incinerator as a proper place for disposing of non-degradable waste instead of throwing waste in Sarada Khola. Community people were also taught about the segregation of degradable and non-degradable waste, the 3R(Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle) principle of waste management and proper disposal

Workshop On Healthcare and Pharmaceutical Waste Management

On June 24, 2022, a workshop entitled "Health care and Pharmaceutical Waste Management" was held in Auditorium Hall of LA GRANDEE. The workshop was organized by International Pharmaceutical Students Federation together with NPSA, PUSPA, GPAST in coordination with LA GRANDEE International College. 50 plus students from the faculty of pharmacy and public health participated in the workshop. Ex-student of LA

GRANDEE and the Public health officer of WRH, Mr. Nabin Khadka and Administrative Officer of PMC, Ms. Kalpana Baral, facilitated the workshop. Chief guest, Dr. Dhakaram Bhandari, Executive Director of Gandaki Province Academy of Science and Technology, delivered his remarks during closing session, while principal of college distributed certificates to the particicipants.

Activities of STUDENT CLUBS



Training on "Model-View-Controller"



Ms Astha Shrestha and Ms Sapana Baniya of BCA 6th semester conducted a training session on an important programming paradigm, the MVC (Model, View, Controller) framework on 1st July, 2022.

The trainers explained Model-View-Controller as a software architecture or design pattern used in software engineering to isolate application's functionality from the display or presentation while simultaneously promoting code usability.

43 students from BCA 4th and 6th semesters participated in the training. The motive of the training was to help participants understand the MVC framework to manage applications and program interfaces efficiently.

Astha Shrestha contemplated how it is contrary to managing the entire project on a single file, and provided a demonstration how MVC distributes the project into a model (this model directly manages the application's data and business logic), a view (the view layer displays data to the user in any format and layout that is available), and a controller (this layer accepts input and turns it into commands for the model (for business logic execution) and/or view (UI)).

Training on "Version Control using GIT"

On 17 June 2022, LA GRANDEE Tech Talk Committee organized a training with a demonstration on Git repository and version controlling. BCA 6th Semester students, Mr Dammar Khadayat and Mr Bidhan Bhuwai were the trainer. More than 40 students from BCA 2nd 4th, & 6th semester participated in the training.

The presenters explained Git as a source code management tool used in DevOps. Since it is a free and opensource version control system, trainers explained about how it is used for efficiently managing small-to-large projects. Furthermore, the presenters shed light on how several developers collaborate on non-linear development by recording changes in the source code. To sum up, they demonstrated the following topics: branching, git pull and push requests, distributed development, Git command-line tools, distributed development environment, and reverting changes.



Investment and Portfolio Management Training

LA GRANDEE BIZ Center successfully organized a training on "Investment and Portfolio management Training" on May 27. BBA 8th Semester Student, Sagar Thapa, Bishow Adhikari, Bikalpa Regmi were the trainer while President of LA GRANDEE BIZ CENETER Sagar Thapa chaired the program. Through this training, 60plus students were able to know about various investment area in Nepal, and way to make investment of small fund.



Interaction on Harassment and Legal Action"

On June 27, 2022, LA GRANDEE BIZ Center successfully organized discussion Program on "Discussion on Harassment and Legal Action" by outsourcing resource person DSP of District Police Office, Kaski Mr. Sundar Tiwari and Advocate as well as Faculty of the college Mr. Durgesh Pant.

The speakers emphasized how sexual harassment is far more difficult to speak out about. Also, they mentioned during

these situations can be distressing and finding assistance might be difficult. If you suspect you have a problem, speak about it and seek for legal routes. May Measurement Month



May Measurement Month (MMM) is a global annual campaign campaigned by the International Society of Hypertension with a motive to raise awareness of the need for people to get their blood pressure checked. The primary aim



of MMM is simply to raise awareness of blood pressure measurement and hypertension.

In coordination with the Nepal Developmental Society, Members from Ideas for LA Grandee actively participate in the May Measurement Month campaign every year voluntarily. This year several campaigns were conducted in different places of Pokhara Metropolitan City, Kaski and Aandhikhola RM of Syangja.

Throughout the campaign conducted, more than a thousand people benefited by knowing their blood pressure status. During the campaign, the participants were counselled about risk factors of high blood pressure, possible health complications, preventive measures and healthy eating practices needed to adopt.

School Health Program on CSE



Comprehensive Sexuality Education (CSE) is a rightsbased and gender-transformative approach, whether in school or outside of school. It is most effective when CSE is taught by integrating age-appropriate information that accounts for the developing capacities of young people. Analyzing the current situation of young people in our country and adolescent health, Ideas for LA Grandee conducted School Health Program on CSE on 7th March 2022 at Shree Krishna Secondary School, Masbar, Pokhara. The main objective of the program was to aware adolescent school children about good touch, bad touch, and sexual education and to reduce sexual-related misconceptions and crime. More than 60 students from classes 8, 9, and 10 participated in the program. The program was facilitated by the president Mr Jeevan Bhandari, VP Mr Subin Shrestha, Program coordinator Ms Sapana Thapa and Secretary Ms Sweta Silwal.

World Asthma Day 2022 Celebration



Every year World Asthma Day is celebrated on the first Tuesday of May. This year World Asthma Day 2022 was celebrated on May 3 with the theme of Closing Gaps in Asthma Care. Although asthma cannot be cured, it is possible to manage asthma to reduce and prevent asthma attacks, also called episodes or exacerbations.

Exam Department Activities for Spring 2021
