semester student, conducted a training session on Mobile Photography at Seminar Hall in La Grandee. He demonstrated how to manage natural light, camera angles, professional



features in a camera, and different techniques for various scenarios. 20 plus students including some faculties participated in the training.

## **Semester Projects**

According to the curriculum of Bachelor's in Computer Application at Pokhara University, students are required to complete a total of 4 projects in the II, IV, VI, and VIII semesters. Through out the semester, students involve in different projects and platforms as per the semester courses. **Project-I**: Stuents of BCA 2<sup>nd</sup> semester completed a total of 8 projects in C Programming Language. Students appeared their final presentation with demonstration on August 11, 2023 in presence of Supervisor Mr. Ramesh Chalise and External evaluator Mr. Yam Baral, Lecturer of JMC. The projects presented by the students include Image Processing, Student Record Management, Student Biiling System, Quiz Game, Restaurant Food Order System, House Rental System, Typing Speed Tracker and Spa Appointment Booking.

**Project-II:** BCA 4<sup>th</sup> semester students completed a total of 12 projects in Visual Programming Language. Supervised by Er. Rishi Saran Khanal, Er. Ram Chandra Poudel Timilsina, CEO of Dynamic Tech evaluated the final presentation and demonstration of the group project on August 4, 2023. Projects demonstrated were Entrance Test System, Book Shop Management System, Flappy Box Game, Residency Management System, Library Management System, Music Class Management System, Trip Planner Application, Café Management System, Budget Management System, Grocery Store Management System, Mero School, and Clothmania.

The 6<sup>th</sup> semester and 8<sup>th</sup> semester students have completed their projects and scheduled to be demonstrated in September 2023.

Project development helps students implement their programming knowledge in real-time projects. Through

this, they can learn about the development process, team collaboration, and ways to address issues that arise while working on a complete project.





### RESEARCH PROPOSAL DEFENSE

On January 30, 2023, students of BBA 6th semester presented their research proposal as part of learning activity for the course Business Research Method. Faculties Puspanjali Bhandari and Bishnu Timilsina had covered the course and assigned students to prepare proposals based on their study and field of interest. Prior to research proposal drafting, students were oriented for the proposal writing on October 14, 2022 in which students were given guidance for essential concepts and tools for preparing research proposals. Through the orientation and regular guidance from the faculties, students gained significant new insights into the logical structures and narrative pathways of persuasive arguments that are essential to effective proposal writing. During the presentation, students were found to be able to illustrate the principles for writing clear and concise research proposals.

### INTERNSHIP ORIENTATION AND DEFENSE

As per curriculum, students of BBA 7th semester completed their internship in various organizations around Pokhara inclusive of financial institutions, corporate houses and service industries for a minimum period of 45 days. After completion, students submitted their reports and presented their internship learning and experiences on February 1 and 2, 2023. Mr. Subash Malla, faculty of Pokhara University evaluated the presentation as the external. The internship orientation was conducted on October 13, 2022 and was completed by January 21, 2023. Faculty Bishnu Timilsina facilitated the orientation session. The major objective of such program is to give students the real exposure of their knowledge and understandings; making them prepared with professional skills and experiences for future. In fact, "Internship" is also the answer of a burning question BBA department organized an orientation on "Project Report Writing" for BBAVI semester day and morning shift students on 24th and 25th of April 2023. This orientation program was conducted by BBA program coordinator Suraj Gaudel. This program equipped them with essential skills to organize their thoughts and ideas coherently, resulting in clear and concise reports. It also enhanced their research skills as they were also taught how to gather relevant information and cite sources accurately. Moreover, orientation sessions helped students understand the importance of proper formatting, grammar, and punctuation, enabling them to create polished and professional reports. Furthermore, it fostered critical thinking, as students learn to analyze data, draw conclusions, and present logical arguments. Ultimately, orientation on report writing empowered students with a valuable skill set that will benefit them in academia and future professional endeavors.

Through practical exercises and projects, students can develop their skills and gain a deeper understanding of media practices. Engaging in media practicum and demo press release activities helps students develop a range of professional skills essential for a career in media. They learn effective communication, writing, editing, and research skills. These skills are valuable not only in journalism but also in various other professions that require strong communication abilities.

## LEARNING THROUGH OBSERVATION



Movie-based learning has emerged as a powerful educational tool, offering numerous benefits to the students. In order to make familiar with this powerful

educational tool and changing learning environment, students of BBA II semester observed movies based on human psychology. Students then made presentations based on their observation which started on May 18, 2023 and continued for some series. Faculties Dipendra Pahari and Narayan Karki evaluated the activities. We have found that visual and auditory elements used in movie support our students to learn complex concepts easily and in more memorable ways. The basic objective of this activity is that movies stimulate critical thinking and analysis skills and thus Students could analyze characters, plot developments, and underlying themes, encouraging deeper comprehension and interpretation. They can also compare and contrast movies with written texts, enhancing their comprehension skills.

## A CAPTIVATING GUEST LECTURE

The Art of Storytelling in Media Top of Form On June 21,2023, a guest lecture on "Art of Storytelling in Media" was delivered to the students of BBA VII day and morning shift. Guest speakers, Pom Narayan Shrestha (President of Pokhara Tourism Council) and

Ramesh Paudel (Executive Director of Barahi FM) explained the techniques and importance of storytelling in the field of media. They

## **Community Health Diagnosis**



The Community Health Diagnosis, or CHD, one-month field residential practice of the sixth semester lasted from June 4th to July 3rd, 2023. It is a community-based, integrated, comprehensive field experience for building the skills and abilities expected of public health professionals. It also assists students in developing a preventive mindset and attitude to identify health problems based on the genuine requirements of the community and fix those problems via the execution of the Micro Health Project (MHP). The batch of 35 BPH students in 2019 was sorted into three groups: A, B, and C. The separated groups were sent to the Tanahun district for a one-month residential CHD in Wards 6 (Jaisehatiya), 7 (Kotdurbar), and 8 (Charghare), respectively Students from each group conducted the cross-sectional descriptive study on a total sample of 400 houses. Each group was given the task of determining the health issues in their allocated wards and creating and implementing the Micro Health Project (MHP). Data were gathered using both qualitative and quantitative methods, and both SPSS and MS Excel were used for analysis. Additionally, students also carried out different health intervention programs at school and in the community. The BPH department coordinator, Mr. Keshab Raj Adhikari, observed the final community assembly in all three wards.





### Waste Incinerator Model as MHP

A Micro-Health Project (MHP) refers to a small-scale, focused, and targeted health intervention or initiative designed to address specific health issues or challenges within a community or a particular population group. These projects typically aim to identify, address, or prevent specific health problems, promote health education and awareness, or enhance healthcare services within a limited scope. MHPs are characterized by their feasibility, efficiency, and potential for creating tangible positive impacts within a relatively short time frame. It involves using local resources resourcefully. The students of BPH 6th semester (batch 2019) during the CHD activities built this non-degradable waste incinerator as a MHP. It was put in place to control improper rubbish disposal in Kotdurbar Ward No. 7 of the Rishing municipality. This incinerator for non-biodegradable waste aids in turning more trash into ash. The locals in Kotdurbar were glad and happy to use this incinerator as a proper location to dispose of

The 3R (reduce, reuse, and recycle) Principle for proper trash management was also taught to the community members, who were instructed to separate the non-degradable waste from the recyclable waste.

## Intervention on Source of Water

of LA GRANDEE Students International college conducted drinking water source cleaning program at Rishing Rural Municipality ward-6, Jaisihatiya with the participation of 20 members on 26th July 2023. The main objective was to clean drinking water source which have been used by all the community people. Cleaning the drinking water source helps to provide pure and safe drinking water to community and thus prevents from communicable diseases and promote health. Community members actively participated and showed their great interest.





## School Health Program on Menstrual Hygiene

Menstrual hygiene refers to the practices and care taken by individuals during their health, comfort and well-being. Analyzing the current situation of young people in our country and Rishing rural municipality ward 7- Kot Durbar, Ideas for LA GRANDEE conducted School Health Program on Menstrual Hygiene on 20th June 2023 at Shree Amar Basic School, Rishing-7, Arkhalchhap, Tanahun. The main objective of the program was to promote a healthy, comfortable and empowered experiences for individuals during their menstrual cycle. More than 35 students from classes 6, 7 and 8 participated in the program. The program was facilitated by Anju Lamichhane, Anushk Ranjit, Aayusha Ghale, Deepika Baral, Jyoti Chhetri, Prajwal Baral, Prashant Pahari, Rabina Baral, Santosh Adhikari, Susan Neupane and Yamuna Patani.

Ankit Poudval from BCA VI demonstrated various aspects of version control systems and their applications. He explained the differences between Git and GitHub, demonstrated how to create a repository and push it to GitHub, outlined the steps for pushing, pulling, merging, and branching, and

addressed common issues that may arise when using GitHub in their projects.

Mr. Gaurav Ghimire from BCA - III mentioned that the training proved to be useful for their upcoming projects, as it provides valuable insights into tracking and managing changes within their software code.

## **Activities of Student Clubs**

## **Game Development Using Js**

In collaboration with Code for Change, La Grandee Tech Talk organized a program about game development using JavaScript for all interested students.

Twenty-two students from different colleges participated in a two-day workshop on the 5th and 6th of May 2023 while the orientation and orientation session was conducted on 1st May, 2023

Arjun Adhikari was the presenter and gave a demonstration about game development using JavaScript on the first day, along with an application of Node.js as a server-side scripting language. He demonstrated the creation of a Flappy Bird game using JavaScript and a simple CRUD (Create, Read, Update, Delete) application using Node.js and MongoDB.

Code for Change Pokhara is a dynamic organization of IT students dedicated to fostering a strong connection between IT students and industry professionals.

## **Quality Assurance (QA)** Workshop

On 24th July, 2023, Code for Change in coordination with LA GRANDEE Tech Talk and Janakari Tech organized the orientation followed by the workshop on Quality Assurance Testing on 1st and 2<sup>nd</sup> of July.

Sagar Gurung presented the importance of automated testing in the modern web development testing process, along with a demonstration of the different tools required and the syntax used for automated testing. More than 25 students from various colleges including LA GRANDEE participated and practically learnt the OA skills.

## **Open Street Map Training**



In partnership with GEO Society WRC Pokhara, the La Grandee successfully TechTalk team completed a two-days workshop on 11th and 12th of May 2023 on the **OSM** platform for BCA IV, VI, and VIII students.

OSM is a collaborative platform free from commercial restrictions. widely used to create digital maps, increase the availability of geographical information, support disaster relief efforts, and provide a platform for innovation and development.

Students received information on how to contribute data and make edits to the map in OSM, as well as how to integrate OSM into their projects.

Students at LA GRANDEE are engaged in various activities besides curriculum and one such effective activity is the Idea Pitching for Business Startup. To encourage students to start their own businesses, the BBA department in coordination with BBA students' club LA GRANDEE Biz Center conducted an orientation and workshop on "Idea Pitching for Business" with the aim of developing a business plan that students wished to pursue upon their university graduation. Students from the BBA VII semester, both morning and day shifts, participated in the event. Initially, they were provided with orientations and guidelines by the faculty members of Entrepreneurship, Bishnu Timilsina and Sudip Gurung. After a series of discussions, the students eventually formulated their own proposals and submitted them to the department. Later on January 19 and 20, 2023, BBA VII semester students pitched their Idea on different businesses.

### TECHNICAL TRAINING FOR DOCUMENTATION

Report Writing is a complex and creative process that is an essential skill logging of events, activities and for effective communication as well. It involves the refining of ideas and expression, coupled with presentation and editing. Any writing, particularly report writing, can be modeled as a recursive problem-solving process and it would remain incomplete without being proficient to computer application tools. To fulfill such aspiring needs of management students of BBA VI semester, Technical Training for Documentation was organized in coordination with LA GRANDEE Biz Center. This training was facilitated by Subin Bhandari who is one of our ex disciples from Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA) program. In the training, students were trained on the Microsoft office tools for composing, revising and editing text during report writing. Furthermore, it is also an unique example of how students in LA GRANDEE share and transfer their knowledge and skill among themselves. The program was held on 15 June 2023.



## **INVESTMENT AWARENESS PROGRAM**
